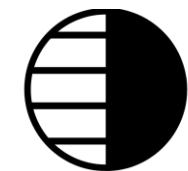

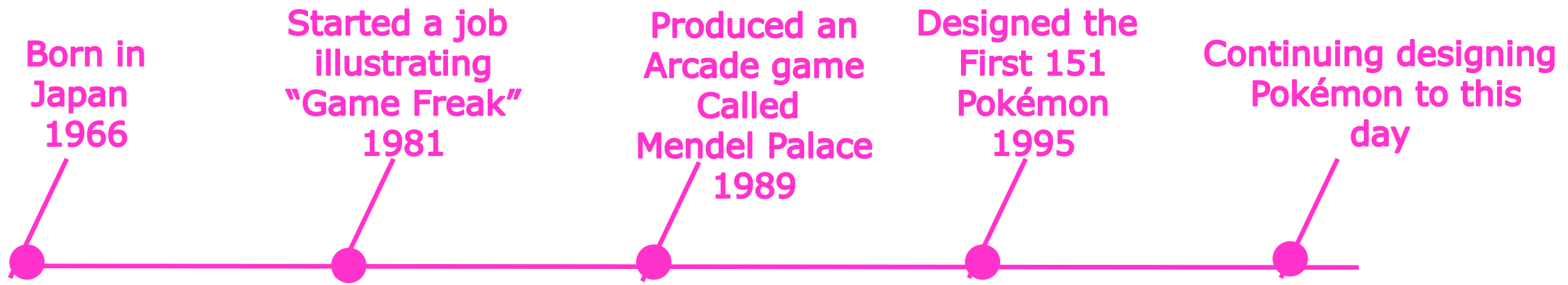

Tone and shadow make a drawing more 3D (dimensional) making it more realistic.

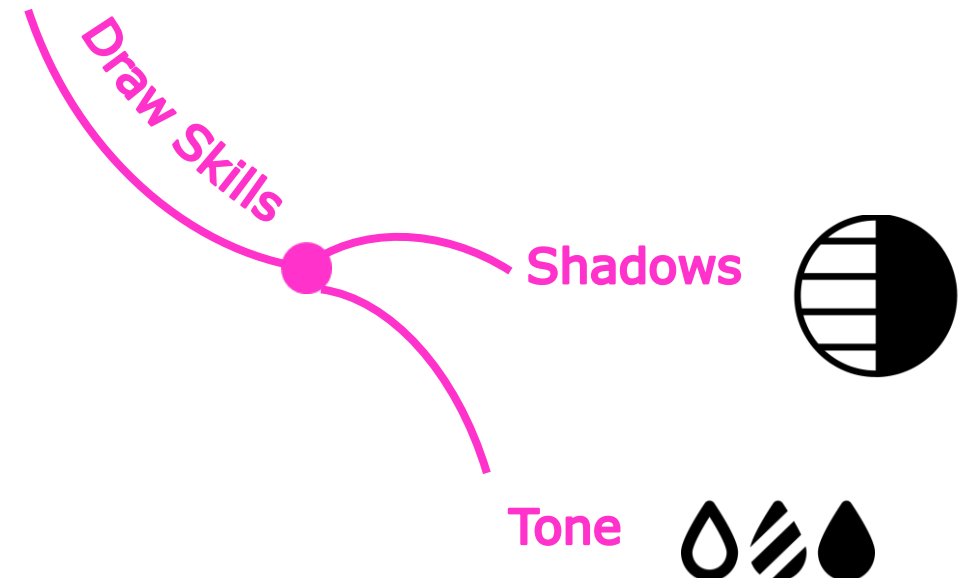
Key Vocabulary

Stem Sentence

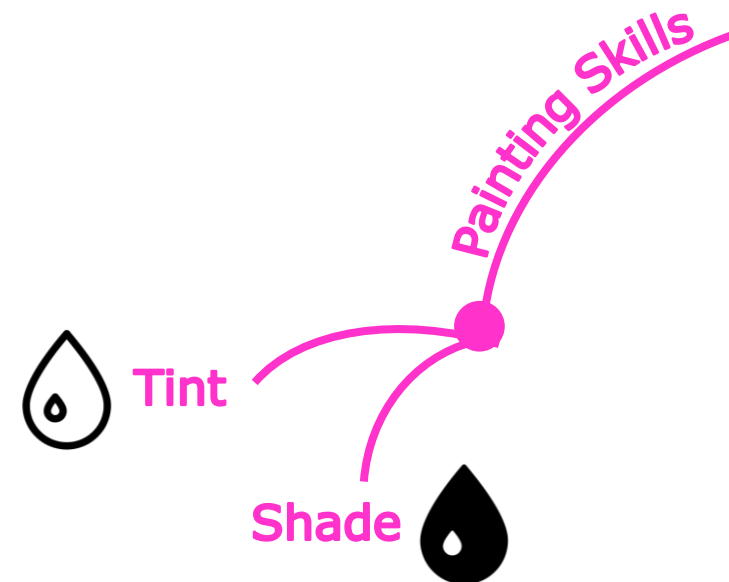
Shade and tone make a drawing more realistic.
